BOUYGUES ADDED TO THREE INTERNATIONAL SRI* INDICES

Bouygues has been added to three SRI (Socially Responsible Investment) indices and thus reaps the rewards of the considerable efforts made by its five business segments in the human resources, social and environmental domains. The indices are the following: MSCI Global Sustainability, STOXX Global ESG, and Euronext Vigeo Eurozone 120.

The efforts of the Group's teams have been recognised in the following areas:

- strengthening the Group's position as a benchmark player in innovative solutions for infrastructures and cities that respond to societal expectations, the scarcity of resources, climate change, and the erosion of biodiversity;

The **MSCI global sustainability** index that Bouygues has been added to includes companies with high CSR performances compared to other players in their sector. The MSCI indices assess CSR criteria on a world scale, covering both developed and emerging markets. As a part of the MSCI Group, MSCI ESG Leader is a US rating agency whose analyses cover more than 5,000 stocks.



The **STOXX Global ESG Leaders** index includes the world leaders on the social, environmental and governance themes. It showcases the best organisations on the basis of three criteria, measured by the indicators provided by the analysis firm Sustainalytics. The agency provides data on more than 4,000 companies, States and public institutions around the globe. STOXX Ltd is a joint venture founded in 1998 by Dow Jones and Company, Deutsche Börse Group and SWX Swiss Exchange. It manages a group of equity indices that are considered as benchmarks in Europe.



The **Euronext Vigeo Eurozone** index lists the 120 companies of the European zone which are the most advanced in terms of environmental, social and governance performance. This index is part of a range of seven indices developed in partnership between Vigeo and Euronext.
