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## COM'IN, A START-UP FROM BOUYGUES' INTRAPRENEURSHIP PROGRAMME, WINS A "TP 2019" AWARD

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On Wednesday 27 November, at the French National Public Works Federation's Innovation Days event, Com'in, a start-up created as part of the Bouygues group's intrapreneurship programme, won the "TP 2019" award in the Start-ups category. This award recognises the creative solutions of independent start-ups, and of those supported by a civil works company or group, that are less than five years old. These solutions must help building and civil works firms to expand or to improve their performance and practices.

Com'in is a platform that analyses and manages noise, dust and mobility-related disturbances (traffic congestion, soiled road surfaces, etc.) in real time. Thanks to smart sensors fitted around worksites, a mobile app used by local residents to report disturbances and a self-learning algorithm, worksite supervisors can use the solution to make the right choices in terms of works execution. The tool identifies the type and location of disturbances and, via feedback from local residents, it provides operational managers with the actually perceived level of disturbance, therefore enabling them to interrupt or continue certain types of work or to adapt phasing, equipment or means of protection. It also provides a rapid response to local residents when they report their complaints.

The Com'in solution, currently in use on five worksites around the Paris region (the Grand Paris Express and EOLE rapid transport projects), is undergoing trials and will be rolled out at other new locations over the next few months. The solution has already attracted interest from several private and public entities concerned about better managing the level of disturbances around their worksites.

This "TP" award is great recognition for the Bouygues group's intrapreneurship programme "Innovate like a Start-up", which helped create and nurture Com'in. The solution, created almost two years ago, is currently in the acceleration phase thanks to financing from Bouygues Construction, where the founder is from, and Colas. Intrapreneurship gives employees the chance (whatever their profession or specialisation) to become entrepreneurs thanks to the support and expertise of the Group's business segments.
