With effect from 1 September, Marie-Luce Godinot, aged 50, is the Bouygues group's Senior Vice-President, Innovation, Sustainable Development and Information Systems.



A graduate of École Polytechnique (1994) and of École Nationale Supérieure des Télécommunications (1996), she joined Bouygues Construction in 2001. After having held various posts at STRUCTIS, Bouygues Construction's IT entity, she took responsibility for the SAP EDIFICE project in 2009, whose aim was to standardise all accounting and management processes in the company's entities.

In 2015, she was appointed Director of Innovation and Sustainable Development and then, in 2018, Executive Vice-President of Bouygues Construction in charge of Digital Transformation, Innovation and Sustainable Development. In 2019, she extended her responsibilities to Information systems.

At Bouygues SA, Marie-Luce Godinot will be responsible for Innovation, Sustainable development (climate and biodiversity) and Information systems (cybersecurity, digitisation, artificial intelligence). She will also be tasked with facilitating exchanges between the Group's business segments in order to bolster the coordination of Bouygues' purchasing policies.

She will report directly to Edward Bouygues, Deputy Chief Executive Officer of the Group.
