The event brought together 500 Bouygues Construction guild members from seven different countries (including France, Morocco, Singapore, Thailand and Hong Kong) over the weekend.

Founded in 1963 by Francis Bouygues, the Minorange Guild initially had just 42 members. The aim of this unique workplace community is to reward and foster the loyalty of the Bouygues group's best workers. With its nine guiding values of respect, exemplarity, respect for a job well done, availability, pride in belonging, team spirit, imparting of knowledge, professional skills and entrepreneurial spirit, the Guild remains one of the Bouygues group's greatest success stories.

Today, there are almost 600 members in twelve guilds around the world, helping to build structures as prestigious as they are complex, such as Parc des Princes soccer stadium and the Paris Philharmonic Concert Hall and the King Power Mahanakhon Tower in Thailand to name but a few. And as further proof of the adaptability of the Minorange Guild spirit, a new guild is in the process of being created at Equans.
